It has not been the intent of of the Florida District Bylaws to preclude someone from becoming a candidate for office prior to serving as a District Committee Chairperson, only that they must have served in this capacity prior to taking the district officer position on October 1.

An amendment to the Bylaws of the Florida District of Key Club International Inc. was presented, having been approved by the Key Club board at their April 7, 2018 Spring board meeting. Lt. Governor Clevenger made a motion to approve the amendment. Lt. Governor Hedges seconded and the motion passed.
