Monday, May 16 - Tour of the FRIB



Outreach Coordinator Zachary Constan, Ph.D, provided a tour of the Facility for Rare Isotope Beams (FRIB) on Monday, May 16. MSU operates the FRIB for the U.S. Department of Energy Office of Science (DOE-SC). FRIB is funded by the DOE-SC, MSU and the State of Michigan with support of the DOE-SC Office of Nuclear Physics. The FRIB enables scientists to make discoveries about the properties of rare isotopes (that is, short-lived nuclei not normally found on Earth.) To generate the isotopes, FRIB will accelerate a beam of atomic nuclei to half the speed of light and send them shooting down a 450-metre pipe, before crashing them into a target that causes some of the atoms to frament into smaller combinations of protons and neutrons.

The FRIB officially opened on May 2 and provided nearly 1,000 tours during their countdown to opening event. Research projects have already started.
