### SUMMARY

This was an incredibly productive year for the Club. The Board began developing plans for a scholarship program and decided to increase the Terrific Kids Program to additional schools. Club Liaisons for the three sponsored Key Clubs were appointed so that we could have a more active role in Key Club activities. In April, a group of members met with Superintendent of Schools Authement to discuss expanding the Terrific Kids Program. In May we hosted three Terrific Kids Camp Days for approximately 150 kids. The year ended with the development of an “I-Plan” Strategic Plan that would guide the focus of club activities for the next three years. Kiwanis International celebrated 30 years of women in Kiwanis; our club honored Donna Cafferata and 20 other women currently members of our club. Achieved Gold Club status for The Eliminate Project (\$109,000 = 60,700 women immunized.)
