What do we do?

Each year, Kiwanis clubs around the world:

- Sponsor over 150,000 service projects
- Devote more than 19 million hours to service
- Raise about \$133 million

Where are we?

Over 8,300 Kiwanis clubs in 85 nations and geographic areas (as of 12/2019)

When did Kiwanis begin?

Founded in 1915 in Detroit, Michigan

- 3. To promote the adoption and the application of higher social, business, and professional standards.




The Kiwanis Objects

- 6. To cooperate in creating and maintaining that sound public opinion and high idealism which make possible the increase of righteousness, justice, patriotism, and goodwill.




Kiwanis structure

Kimanis Club of Alexandria about 80 members




