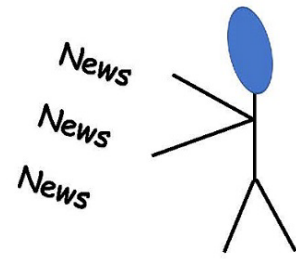

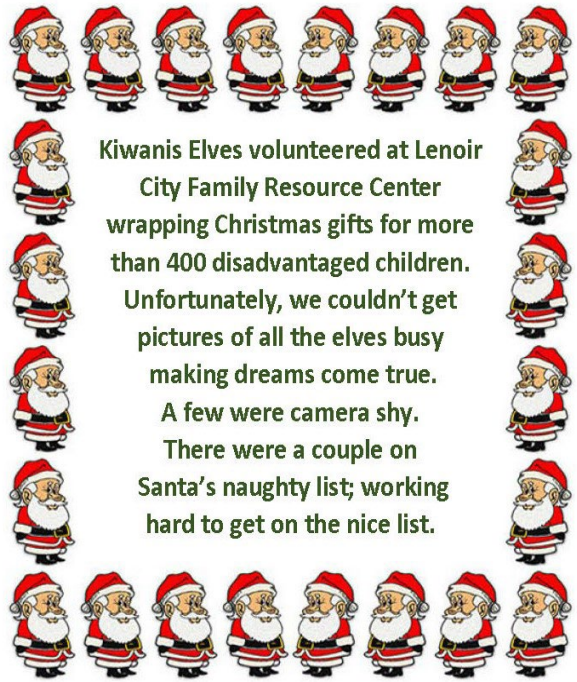
Weekend Food 4 kids
