This endeavor fosters an environment that celebrates literacy and promotes lifelong learning.



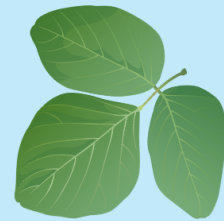

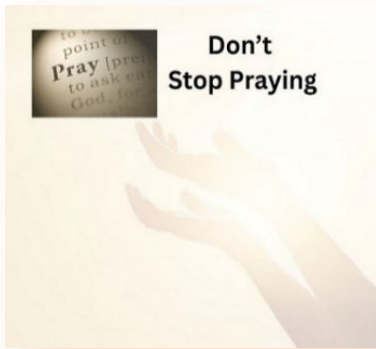
