On Becoming a Kiwanian

THE APPLICATION PROCESS:

Membership in the Kiwanis Club of Hendersonville requires [1] the submission of an application, [2] payment of an initiation fee at time of application, and [3] receipt of a clear criminal background check. The release form for the background check is available from the club and should be submitted by the applicant directly to Mind Your Business, Inc. The club will pay for the cost of the background check.

Your membership officially begins when the Board of Directors approves your application, which will usually be the 2nd Monday of the month following receipt of a complete application, initiation fee, and clear criminal background check.

The (one time) application fee of \$90 needs to be submitted with your completed application. The dues are: \$60 per quarter.

WHAT DOES KIWANIS MEMBERSHIP INVOLVE?

The Hendersonville Kiwanis Club welcomes your interest in membership. We are a global organization of volunteers dedicated to improving the world, one child and one community at a time. This club of over 100 members has served the community and national and worldwide efforts for over 100 years - since March 1921.

You will receive many personal benefits from being a Kiwanian, such as having weekly fellowship with other community leaders and volunteers, gaining satisfaction from helping make the lives of children better, improving the community where we live, establishing new friendships and business contacts, and much more. Financial Commitments:

- Following board approval of your membership, you will be invoiced for prorated dues—from date of approval to the end of the quarter—which covers Kiwanis International and Carolinas District dues, club administrative costs. When you attend luncheon meetings you will pay for meals at the door.
- Members are also expected to support club fundraisers by volunteering at, and in some cases selling tickets to, these events. Additionally, members are encouraged to contribute to the scholarship fund and any other major club fund-raising efforts.

Involvement in Kiwanis activities is an important part of being a member. You will be expected to participate in the following ways:

- Attend regular meetings (not a requirement, but strongly encouraged).
- Actively participate in club service projects and fundraisers.
- Recruit, sponsor, and support new members.
- Be involved in other community service volunteer activities of your choice.
- Consider taking an active role in club activities through committee and/or board membership.
- Report monthly your Kiwanis and non-Kiwanis volunteer hours.
