Program/Speaker: Craft Talk-Lynne Thompson.

Lynne's parents were married during the Great Depression & needed to keep their marriage secret for 2 years for fear of losing their jobs. Her mother was a teacher in a one-room school house teaching 8 grades. At that time teachers were not allowed to be married. Her dad had a high security bank position and also was not allowed to be married.

Lynne first lived in Sherman Oaks & then to LA to be closer for her dad's work. No freeways in those days. She attended Hamilton HS and masonry was important to her mother, so she became a Job's Daughter & leader in the organization. She first attended San Jose St and joined Kappa Kappa Gamma sorority. She transferred to UCLA as a junior to be closer to her parents. She met her life partner, Joe, at age 20 and were married before finishing college. They had their first child before her practice teaching assignments. They settled first in Burbank and then Shadow Hills, but moved to LCF in 1975 with two more children and two dogs!

She taught elementary school in LAUSD for about 30 years as a 5th grade teacher and had many ESL students. Lynne retired in 1991 to help her aging parents and also did some tutoring in the area. She began volunteering in different philanthropic organizations, as well. When Joe retired from So Cal Gas, they began traveling the world.

Finally now in her 80's, she is grateful for her loving husband, 3 grown children & spouses and especially their 9 grandchildren, who are all college graduates. As of July,4 grandkids will be married. She also shared some life in pictures on our screen, which was shown on her 80th birthday. What fond memories.
