

But we still will have a deficit this year too. Weekly rent for our parish hall is our most expensive Admin cost. We hope to find ways to make more money for our Admin account-maybe a Bingo night that Chuck will run? The members did rework some of the amounts and who we will continue giving monies to. Martha & Cindy will then present the revised budget to the Board at their meeting in September for approval and then to the membership. Thanks to all for helping out today. Hope everyone got an insight into how our monies are earned and spent.
