




#### **Program/Speaker:** CVHS WellNest - Daniella Torrecilla


Our speaker today is a counselor at CVHS in her 2<sup>nd</sup> year there. She previously counseled middle school students for 8 years. She graduated from CSUN and decided to work near her family, which is why she stayed in the area. The WellNest Center is fairly new and anyone is welcome whether they are stressed or happy. She encourages kids to focus their energy on what they can control and not on what they can't control. Stress is a common emotion with teenagers-AP testing, parental expectations etc. The Center offers support and help during the lunch hour and after school. Students who have open periods can also visit the center at that hour. They even have dogs for therapy a couple of days a week. They are open till 4pm and provide lots of snacks. Last year about 2,000 students visited the center. Students can even apply to be a "peer support" person to a student. \$5 gift cards to places like Baskin Robbins & Baja Fresh are given to students as well. They don't provide therapy session but will connect families with therapists who give a 10-session virtual consultation.

Thank you Daniella for a very information program with a slide presentation as well. The students are so lucky to have someone so knowledgeable and caring. Keep up the good work.



Stress Management Activity (Ex: Feeling stressed or overwhelmed)


Motivation (Ex: Tired or having a hard time coming to school or staying focus in class)
