YOUTH PROTECTION & BACKGROUND CHECKS

As the premier provider of youth service clubs and programs, Kiwanis International holds itself and its members to the highest standards of conduct and awareness.

In addition to the training, we got today ...

OUR CLUB MEMBERS THAT WORK DIRECTLY WITH YOUTH MUST DO MORE TO COMPLY WITH KIWANIS GUIDELINES.

This applies to our members that attend Builders Club and Key Club Meetings at the schools, and those that have phone conversations with any students in these clubs. If our club wants to include students at any event like our French Toast Breakfast, Memorial Day Parade, etc ... we must have 2 people at the event that have completed these 2 things so general members are welcome to complete these things to help us be able to invite students to participate at an event.

1. Praesidium abuse prevention courses:

Kiwanis International partners with global abuse prevention educator Praesidium Inc. to conduct youth protection and child abuse prevention courses, online free courses.

Here is the link for instructions how to access the online training.

The 2nd column applies to us: ALP Das & Advisors (CKI, Builders and Key Clubs)

We need to take (6) courses: Abuse Risk Management for Volunteers, Social Media Safety, Preventing Sexual Activity Among Adolescents, Duty to Report, Meet Sam, and It Happened to Me.

Very Important: when you are setting up your praesidium account, DO NOT SELECT CHAPERONE ... WE ARE NOT CHAPERONES and if you select that the correct 6 online courses will NOT go to your account. Select the other option, not sure exactly what that is but it might be VOLUNTEER or ADVISOR. Navigating all this is not easy, sorry but it is what it is.

2. Live Scan Fingerprint background check:

California law Assembly Bill 506 requires this, and Kiwanis is specifically using Applicant Services company. Here is a link with detailed information.

Go to applicantservices.com/Kiwanis to initiate your Live Scan background check. It costs \$50, and our club with reimburse that expense if you submit a receipt.
