There were attorneys and other people there to help them fill out forms, cancel subscriptions, provide information etc. What an amazing service! Joy Gibson gave \$5 as his son's house burned and is now living with them temporarily. Despite that sadness he was still able to tell one of his fun jokes. **Martha Burns** pledged a happy \$10 as she is going Sunday to see her favorite group "The Texas Tenors" sing at the Cerritos Performing Arts Center, and her son's former HS soccer coach who moved to Laguna Beach is going too.
