Program/Speaker: Anxiety Tips-Kristine Whitson

A versatile and accomplished violinist (also wife, mom, & grama), Kristine Whitson has been a member of the LA Phil since 1990. She told us a little bit about the process of applying for the position. About 400 resumes are sent in for one position in the orchestra. She practiced solid for 6 weeks and knew that music and art are subjective, so can be difficult to judge. You are on a 2-year probation and then there is a yes or no vote to be permanent. Thankfully she was accepted. It's hard work but has fun perks. She grew up in a musical family and started playing the violin and piano at the age of four. Her first conductor was very demanding, cranky and critical. But her own struggles with crippling anxiety (panic attacks & stage fright) in her career as a professional violinist led her to faith in Jesus and gained more confidence & became transformed. She couldn't even get her bow on the strings at times and worried she might be fired. Her anxiety got so bad she even thought about jumping out a window. She also learned that if you change your thoughts, you change your situation. Sometimes just taking a deep breath is effective.

She is now a certified Christian life coach specializing in anxiety/stress management, and performance mindset. She takes the mental, physical and spiritual tools she used effectively in her 3 decades as a professional violinist, and shares them with musicians, athletes,

housewives, ballet dancers, artists, executives, public speakers, and anyone who just wants to get better. Thanks Kristine for sharing your experiences with us. What an amazing life you have lead.
