


















#### **Program/Speaker:** YMCA of the Foothills-Joanne Pingry

Joanne officially is the "Director of Mission Advancement" for the Y, which basically means they raise monies. Having a family here in town, she started there first for shorter days, then 20 hrs a week and finally full time now. During Covid the Y lost about 90% of their staff and had to engage members on Facebook or Zoom. She loves connecting with people.

The LCF facility is 67 years old. Founded in 1958 by a small group of community leaders, our Y ran its first programs -- summer camp, youth sports, and Y-Guides -- from a small house in La Cañada. By 1962 a larger group of civic leaders secured a piece of property, raised over \$600,000, and built what is now the Crescenta-Cañada Family YMCA facility. Two other facilities have been built since-the Crescenta Valley Y and the Verdugo Hills Y. Tujunga has great senior events and activities.

Right now they are in "summer camp" mode daily from 8am-5pmat LCE and another in Montrose. On the last day, all campers go to Disneyland. They also have half-day camps, afternoon specialty camps. Camp Fox at Catalina is a week-long camp. Joanne feels the Y is a perfect place for kids to have fun and get away from TV, laptops, cell phones, etc. Currently they have 119 at camps. And camps are from 1-7 weeks long and programs are for body and brain exercises. They also sponsor a program for seniors called "Silver Sneakers," which is often covered by health insurance.

The Y recently hired a new chaplain, as the prior one moved down the street to LA Presbyterian Church. There is a chapel at the Y and they host an annual "Prayer Breakfast." Even tho the "C" in YMCA stands for "Christian," any one of any faith is welcome to join. Many members lost their homes in the Altadena fires and were offered free memberships and clothing. The Y partners with "California Strong" and Ventura County to help raise nearly \$500Kto help those affected by the fires. 94 children are experiencing free summer camps. They also partner with the LA Dodgers and she was able to meet pitcher Clayton Kershaw at one of their functions, who is part of the fundraising program.

Thank you so much Joanne for sharing such a wealth of information to our members. You are certainly a wonderful advocate for the Y and its members. Our club was able to present her with a \$500 check for our local YMCA. Below is listed information about the facilities and programs available. Check them out!
