Program/Speaker: LCF Orthopedic Guild-Joan Cleven & Mary Beth Perrine

The La Cañada Flintridge Orthopaedic Guild is a volunteer organization, founded in 1957, that raises funds and provides support for the Orthopaedic Institute for Children (OIC) in Los Angeles. Mary Ann Hillgren (wife of our city mayor long ago) was the first member of the group. Kiwanis member Jack Labrie's wife Linda was a long time member of the guild.

The OIC provides top orthopaedic medical care to any child with musculoskeletal disorders regardless of ability to pay. They will never turn any child away. Every year Santa arrives in a helicopter and gives out toys all day long. The institute sees about 50,000 patients a year. They hope to open a MRI Center and cost to build is \$2.5 million. To date they have raised \$948K. LCF Guild's most recent gift was \$25K.

Members of the La Cañada Flintridge Orthopaedic Guild (LCFOG) have been donating thousands of hours of volunteer "women"-power through its 68 years of service to the Orthopaedic Institute for Children (OIC) in downtown LA. The Guild also raises funds for the OIC. LCFOG's biggest fundraiser is its annual Book and Author Luncheon. This year's luncheon will be held on Tuesday, Oct. 28.10:30am at the La Cañada Flintridge Country Club; \$75.

Mary Beth is VP of the La Canada branch and became a member in 2000. She acually started going when she was 9 years old, as her mother was one of the founders in 1957. What an amazing organization and right up our alley as our Kiwanis mission is to "serve children of the world." Thank you Joan and Mary Beth for all the "goodies" you brought for our members..
