The Marilyn-Elaine Memorial Scholarship will provide continuing educational assistance to qualified recipients planning to attend a community college, college, or university. Applications become the property of the Kiwanis Club of Carson City. Applicant also is eligible for the Ralph Denny Memorial Scholarship, a one time \$1000.00 award, which may, at our discretion be included with the M-E.

Award & Selection Criteria

Recipients are eligible for \$750.00 per semester for eight consecutive semesters. Selection is based upon the following factors, with special emphasis on the character, personal merit, financial need, and background of each applicant. **Merit may be demonstrated by leadership in school; civic service and other extracurricular activities in addition to academic achievement, dependability and sense of purpose in pursuit of goals.**

Qualifications*

All applicants must:

- Be US Citizens and residents of Carson City or the immediate vicinity.
- If selected to receive the Scholarship, must enroll as a full-time student in an accredited community college, college, or university and meet other requirements such as maintaining a 3.0 or better GPA, and reporting same in a timely manner.
- Be a high school senior, high school graduate, or have passed the GED High School Equivalency Test.
- Fill out our application form completely. **Also submit your most current transcript and one letter of recommendation. Due no later than March 31, to the Guidance Office at Carson High, or mail it to the Kiwanis PO Box postmarked March 31.**
- Note: Please read the application carefully: **Incomplete applications will not be considered for academic awards. Be sure to complete The Biographical Data page!**
