Grant Requirements and Guidelines

The Kiwanis Club of Mason is dedicated to supporting those organizations that encourage and support the children and community of the Mason area. The Club does not normally entertain Foundation grants, exceptions may be made where there is a clearly identifiable project with direct benefits to children living within the Mason City School District.

Please review carefully our minimum requirements for grant application as well as our guidelines for recipients.

Grant Applicant- Minimum Requirements:

1. Have a mission that benefits children or the community as a whole.
2. Serve the Mason/Warren County Area.
3. Benefit more than just one individual.
4. Complete a Grant Application form and return by August 4, 2024.

Grant Recipient- Guidelines:

1. Be willing to publicize their Kiwanis Grant Award.
2. Allow Kiwanis Club of Mason to also publicize the Award.
3. Support Kiwanis by participating in, and/or publicizing our fundraisers.
4. Receive their Award check at a regularly scheduled Kiwanis meeting.
5. Be willing to inform our Club Membership with an overview of your organization if requested.
6. Report back to our Club regarding the use of our Award via our Feedback Form.
7. Understand that Grant Awards are never guaranteed and are contingent upon availability of funds.
8. Understand that Grant Awards are not automatically renewable and must be reapplied for on an annual basis.
