

2025 Four-Year Scholarship Application

Mason Scholarship Foundation is offering an \$8,000 Four-Year College Scholarship grant for 2025 High School Graduates who reside in the Mason City School District. The Mason Scholarship Foundation Four Year College grant is for full-time college students. The grant is awarded as \$2,000 for the first year and is renewable annually at \$2,000 for each of the remaining three years (totaling \$8,000 over four years.)

Selection Criteria

- Student must reside in the Mason City School District or attend Mason High School.
- Minimum 2.50 Cumulative GPA, academic ability and motivation to compete on a college level.
- Preference will be given to candidates who demonstrate commitment to community service, strong educational motivation, leadership skills through their activities in school, faith organizations, youth groups, volunteer efforts, and work experience.
- Attending an accredited four-year college or university program as a full-time student.
- Financial need (see below.)

Scholarship Application Process

- Student must forward one package formatted in PDF or .docx of the following by email to masonscholarshipfoundation@gmail.com. **Application package must include:**
 - o Application,
 - o Personal Statement, and
 - ACT or SAT scores, if applicable.
- **Grade Transcripts** are required and should be submitted to the Mason Scholarship Foundation from school personnel.
- While we highly suggest 3 Letters of Recommendation, a **minimum of two Letters of Recommendation** are required (see below) to consider you eligible for the scholarship.
- Additional information that will assist in the selection process is the FAFSA conclusion page for financial aid.
- Finalists will be asked to come for an in-person interview with our Board of Trustees.

Financial Need

Financial need will be a consideration in the selection process. We encourage you to submit information including your FAFSA conclusion page to demonstrate financial need.

Letters of Recommendation

Choose three people to write letters of recommendation for you, and with whom you are confident will complete them by the deadline. It is strongly recommended that two letters be submitted directly to the Mason Scholarship Foundation from a teacher or other school employee and one letter come directly from an adult who knows you through work or volunteer activities. While we do highly suggest you get three letters of recommendation as part of the application package, a *minimum of two letters of recommendation* must be <u>received by April 11, 2025</u> to consider you eligible for the scholarship. A letter of recommendation must be received directly from the writer to the Mason Scholarship Foundation at the email address below.
