

2025 Two-Year Scholarship Application for students pursuing an Associate Degree or certificate program at a technical or trade school

Mason Scholarship Foundation is offering a \$2,000 Two-Year Scholarship grant for 2025 High School

<u>Graduates</u> who reside in the Mason City School District. The Mason Scholarship Foundation Two-Year Scholarship grant is awarded as \$1,000 for the first year and is renewable at \$1,000 for the second year (totaling \$2,000 over two years.)

Selection Criteria

- Student must reside in the Mason City School District or attend Mason High School.
- Student must seek to continue education at a community college, junior college, or qualified certificate program at a technical or trade school.
- Preference will be given to candidates who demonstrate commitment to community service, strong educational motivation, leadership skills through their activities in school, faith organizations, youth groups, volunteer efforts, and work experience.
- Financial need (see below.)

Scholarship Application Process

- Student must forward one package formatted in PDF or .docx of the following by email to <u>masonscholarshipfoundation@gmail.com</u>. **Application package needs to include:**
 - Application, and
 - Personal Statement.
- **Grade Transcripts** are required and should be submitted to the Mason Scholarship Foundation from school personnel.
- Letter(s) of Recommendation are required (see below.)
- Finalists may be asked to come for an in-person interview with our Board of Trustees.

Letter(s) of Recommendation

Choose a school employee or your employer to write a letter of recommendation for you, and with whom you are confident will return the letter directly to the address below. It is strongly recommended that one letter be submitted directly to the Mason Scholarship Foundation from a teacher or other school employee and one letter come directly from an adult who knows you through work or volunteer activities. A minimum of one letter of recommendation must be received by April 11, 2025 to consider you eligible for the scholarship. We do strongly suggest you get two letters of recommendation as part of the application package. *Letter(s) of recommendation must come directly from the writer to the Mason Scholarship Foundation.*

Financial Need

Financial need will be a consideration in the selection process. We encourage you to submit information including your FAFSA conclusion page to demonstrate financial need.
