

2025 Vocational Scholarship Application for students pursuing Certificate Program at a technical or trade school

Mason Scholarship Foundation is offering a <u>Vocational Scholarship grant for 2025 High School</u>
<u>Graduates</u> who reside in the Mason City School District and are pursuing a qualified certificate
program at an accredited vocational institution for a program lasting up to two years. The Mason
Scholarship Foundation Vocational Scholarship grant award amount will be based on the program cost and
financial need of the applicant but will not exceed \$2,000 over two years (up to \$1,000 per year.) Any awarded
scholarship is paid to the vocational institution on behalf of the enrolled award recipient.

Selection Criteria

- Student must reside in the Mason City School District or attend Mason High School.
- Student must seek to continue education at a qualified certificate program at an accredited technical or trade school.
- Preference will be given to candidates who demonstrate commitment to community service, strong educational motivation, leadership skills through their activities in school, faith organizations, youth groups, volunteer efforts, and work experience.
- Financial need (see below.)

Scholarship Application Process

- Student must forward one package formatted in PDF or .docx of the following by email to masonscholarshipfoundation@gmail.com.
 Application package needs to include:
 - Application, and
 - o Personal Statement.
- **Grade Transcripts** are required and should be submitted to the Mason Scholarship Foundation from school personnel.
- Letter(s) of Recommendation are required (see below.)
- Finalists may be asked to come for an in-person interview with our Board of Trustees.

Letter(s) of Recommendation

A minimum of one letter of recommendation must be received by August 14, 2025 to consider you eligible for the scholarship. We do strongly suggest you get two letters of recommendation as part of the application package. It is required that one letter be submitted directly to the Mason Scholarship Foundation from a teacher/school employee or from an adult who knows you through work or volunteer activities. Letter(s) of recommendation must come directly from the writer to the Mason Scholarship Foundation at the email address below.

Financial Need

Financial need will be a consideration in the selection process. Please complete the *Program Cost and Financials* section of this application. We encourage you to submit information including your FAFSA conclusion page to demonstrate financial need, if available.
