Kiwanis in Pennsylvania Focuses on Early Childhood Development.

Call to Action...there are many ways Kiwanians can help!

1. **Spread the Word -- Build local support by inviting a member of the Early Learning Investment Commission Speakers' Bureau to talk to your Kiwanis Club or other business group. Let us know if you need additional materials to share with others.**
2. **Give of yourself -- Volunteer to be a reader or tutor in a local childcare center and/or encourage your fellow employees and members to be literacy volunteers for young children.**
3. **Encourage your Club's Young Children Priority One (YCPO) Committee Chair to identify and implement opportunities to support the developmental needs of young children from birth to age five.**
4. **Make the Case -- Join our efforts to help policy makers understand the issues at stake. Contact your state Senator and Representative and ask them to support investment in the state's early childhood education programs. You can find biographical and contact information on these leaders and all members of the General Assembly on their web site at www.legis.state.pa.us.**
5. **Consider adopting a local early learning center. Find out what you can do to help a center become a high quality center and provide a great start for their students.**
6. **Participate in the "Learning is Everywhere", "Kindergarten Here I Come", and "Everyday I Learn Through Play" Early Learning Guides project.**
7. **Consider supporting an early intervention program such as the Nurse-Family Partnership.**
