Lavar T. Thomas "Leading from Within"

Leading from Within is about aligning your values with your impact on the world. It requires disrupting self-limiting beliefs, becoming aware of the narratives that shape your identity, and effectively serving others. To effectively motivate others, leaders must understand their internal power to create external impacts.

This Keynote aims to empower attendees to reimagine their leadership and impact, search within and serve a mission that is bigger than themselves. The Keynote will help conference participants to reimagine what is possible when they lead from within.

Lavar T. Thomas is an international speaker, author, and transformational leadership coach. Born in the Brownsville section of Brooklyn, NY, Lavar's desire to help individuals discover their purpose and transform communities has taken him around the world.

Lavar served in the Peace Corps in Rwanda, East Africa where he addressed food insecurity and provided leadership development and financial literacy training to youth within his community. Lavar is a teaching faculty with the Global Citizenship Alliance in Saltzburg, Austria, and founder of "Empower for Greatness", a program that helps aspiring leaders, entrepreneurs, and professionals overcome fear, cultivate resilience, and develop a blueprint for global impact.


His work has led to a TEDx Talk and co-creating Leaders of the Free World. This non-profit organization provides leadership development and international experiences to young black men.


