- Why Protection Matters
 - Key Club 204,917 members
 - Builders Club 26,976 members
 - K-Kids 22,724 members
 - Aktion Club 5,738 members
 - CKI 8,463 members
- 1 in 5 girls and 1 in 13 boys experience abuse (World Health Org. 2022)
- Goals
 - Protect youth from predators
 - Provide youth w/skills and tools
 - Empower & educate adult members
- Youth Protection ABCs
 - A Accessible, high-quality training & resources
 - B Background checks and beyond
 - C Culture of Care



Required Training

- Educate club members annually
- Provide club members with a copy of the
 - Youth Protection Policies & Procedures
- Criminal History Background Check for every club member serving as an advisor for a Service Leadership Program (SLP)
 - Valid for 2 years; cost is \$35 for SLP advisors
 - Volunteers can register & the cost is FREE
- Chaperone (Kiwanis member, faculty member, parent, legal guardian, 21 years of age or older)
- Chaperones for
 - Overnight events: 1 adult to 10 students
 - Single-day event: 1 adult to 50 students


