Hero In Service Nomination Process

The process for nomination and selection of **Kiwanis Hero In Service**:

- A club can nominate a member from their club by completing the nomination form and submit completed form to Lt. Governor and Trustee.
- Complete essay/narrative of no more than 200 words of how the nominee shows that they are a Regional Hero In Service by embodying the Objects of Kiwanis. Please provide specific examples of this.
- The Trustee and Lt. Governors in the Region will review the nominations and select a winner for Hero In Service Award
- Nominees who do not win the Hero In Service award will receive a Letter of Recognition of the nomination.
