1. **DURING COVID PANDEMIC:** Lunches for SCSFD, Cottage Hospital/South Lake HS Bistro Feed those in Need/\$3,000 to our MI Kiwanis Foundation to assist with PPE/ Additional Diapers for Gianna House/Monetary Support to Food Pantries; and more
2. Collected over 8,000 books and distributed throughout communities
3. Special Needs Ice Skating Event (March)... (700 participants)
4. Donated a Lucas 3 Chest Compression Device to SCSFD (February, 2019)
5. Easter Brunch with Pastor (March or April)
6. Key Leader (April-A weekend retreat for youth ages 14-18 years old...we sponsor 5 @ \$260). This program focuses on Servant Leadership, integrity, respect, growth, community and excellence).
7. Scholarship Program (April...8 to 10 recipients receive \$500 to \$1,000)

11. Dictionary Program (October-Nov: presentations along with nearly 900 dictionaries presented to SCS 3rd graders)

13. Salvation Army Bell Ringing (Dec 5TH...at our Kroger Stores)
14. Gianna House – Diaper Program (Provide diapers every other month)
15. Key Club–Year-Round (Lake Shore HS / Grosse Pointe South...Oldest & largest service organization for teens: leadership through services to children and our communities)
