Wayne Frey, also a "Bald Eagle" scout answered "A Scout is Trustworthy, Loyal, Helpful, Friendly, Courteous, Kind, Obedient, Cheerful, Thrifty Brave , Clean, and Reverent."

Our guest speaker today was **Jimmy Jones**, Director, Community Resource Program, Mid-Willamette Community Action Agency. His topic was Homelessness in Marion and Polk Counties. He reports that about 4,000 homeless are in Marion and Polk Counties with about 1,800 of those in Salem.

He listed some Reasons for homelessness including; The elderly being priced out of affordable housing, domestic violence - If someone is fleeing domestic violence, then under federal law they can be considered homeless. On veteran's ... the average age of homeless vets is 54 years old.

Mr. Jones predicted that another huge wage of Veteran's homelessness will happen when veterans return from all the current wars going on. Cities are underfunded to handle the large number of homeless.

Another issue is that there is a lack of coordinated efforts. Some beds at UGM may go unused because families would rather stay together on the street instead of being separated because only men can use UGM. Chronic Homeless - Marion and Polk Counties have twice the national average of 9.4%.

People need more than the 2 years of help currently being offered and as a result become homeless again.

### **Proposed Solution:**

Take care of the most critical 51 homeless with tri-modal issues, that being Physical, Mental and Substance Abuse. This will save about \$400,000 at the Salem Hospital
