Uur guest speaker today was Ellen Egan. Ellen is the President and Chairman of the Board at Egan Gardens. The business was started by her father in 1951. He started on land that was owned by Ellen's great great grandparents in the late 1800's.

Poinsettias are 10% of the crop at Egan Gardens and they require the most intensive care of all the crops of flowers and plants grown there. Last year some 21 varieties of the poinsettias were cultivated and grown. Most were sold for fundraisers and or business to business. They are also used in hanging baskets, which Ellen designs herself and are sold mostly to local churches before Christmas which Ellen calls "All Saints" week as most of the local churches are named after saints. This last year Egan Gardens sold some 16,500 poinsettias.
