both in the U.S. and the U.K.

Mr. James posed the question...Should upwards of \$80 million be spent, and tax payers pay, for upgrades to the city hall, library and police headquarters in Salem? Certainly seismic upgrades should be done to ensure safety in the event of a major earthquake, but what the city is proposing would also include building an underground structure for housing over 200 police vehicles. Vehicles that would be trapped underground when an earthquake occurs.

Salem Community Vision is a group of citizens who are committed to an open public process to explore alternatives to what the city officials are planning. Mr James is a concerned citizen involved with this community group. He is urging folks to get involved and let the powers that be know that this plan should go back to the drawing board.
