Over the years they have held some 300 weddings on the boat which has also been a fun place for dinner cruises on the Willamette.

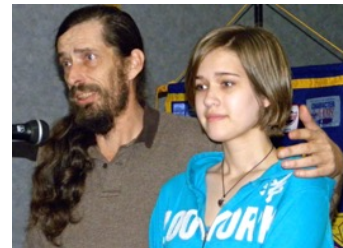
