Salem Kiwanis donates books to two more Head Start Schools

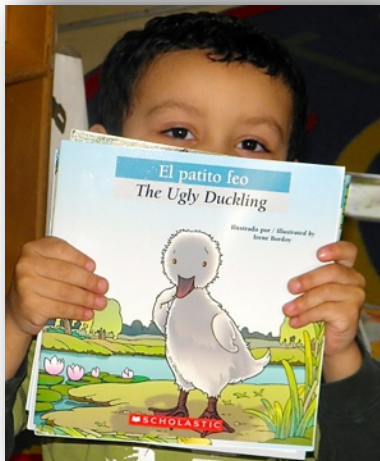
Kroc Center Head Start
