Today's program featured **Marcia Mattoso**, the founder and director of **Hope Station**. Hope Station was opened in 2008 as a 501c3.

Ms Mattoso grew up in Brazil. Her family was poor. Her background is in marriage and family counseling. She went into Non-Profit Management and opened Hope Station to help families in need. The requirement is that at least one in the family must have a job. A monthly fee is charged and the recipient must volunteer at least 2 hours a month.

Ms Mattoso believes in the power of prayer and believes that miracles happen all the time for her and her organization. The success of Hope Station is measured in food donations. The first year Hope Station donated 30,000 lbs of food. The second year, 60,000 lbs and last year, 167,000 lbs. In total over 500,000 lbs of food have been donated. Every month some 200 children are helped by Hope Station.



KOD **Jim Kraugh** was our Kiwanian of the Day today. Jim was born in a small town in Illinois, grew up in Pheonix

Arizona. Went in the Air Force National Guard then got married, raised four children with his wife. She passed away three years ago.

He then went to work for the State of Arizona. Jim moved to Oregon in 1998. He lives in a house that once belonged to Victor Jory.
