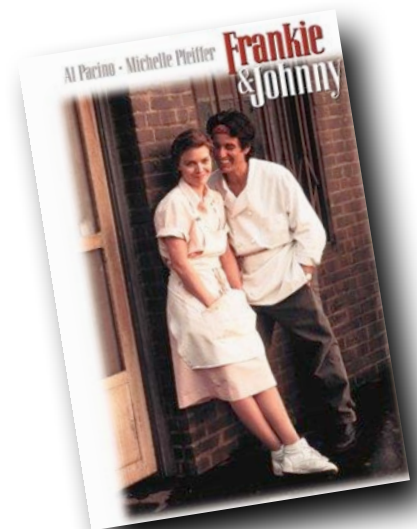


Volunteers are an important asset for the operation, both in the store and in the building of homes. One of the volunteers who works in the store is 86 years old and loves working there four hours a week.
