Hugh was born and raised in Albany, Oregon where he went to high school. He graduated from Willamette University in 1953. He is married and has three children and three step-children.

Hugh is retired from the military after 43 years of both active duty and as a civilian employee. He still works part time with the military.

His career includes being a juvenile court counselor among other things. He first joined Kiwanis in Prineville, Oregon in 1955. After living in the Portland area, he and his family moved to Salem and in 1974 he joined the Salem Kiwanis Club.

Hugh's Kiwanis priorities are the Program Committee and Kiwanis Young Children Priority One.



Brian Clem was our guest speaker today. He is a Democrat Oregon State Representative who represents District 21. He was first elected in 2006. Mr Clem is a fifth generation Oregonian. He is from Coos Bay and graduated from Oregon State University.

He started his own computer services company in 2000 and also operates an international trading company bringing Oregon products to the rest of the world.

His talk today was on the legislature's odd and even year schedules. In the even number years, they meet for up to 35 days, in the odd number years the legislature meets from February through the middle of July. This started after the 2006 session when a commission was formed to study ways to make the legislative process more efficient. Usually in the short sessions, more contentious issues are left for the longer session.

Mr. Clem was asked a couple questions about the legalization of marijuana and a question on the situation with "Cover Oregon."
