Kimberly Helterline is the Executive Director of St. Francis Shelter in Salem. She is the only employee and all other folks who help with running the shelter are volunteers. Kim is a long-time good friend of **John Moody** and they both enjoy



the sport of running.

St. Francis Shelter has been helping families in Salem since 1987. The shelter provides a home for families with children and each family has their own apartment. There are currently 11 families in the apartment complex near South Salem High School. The number of children currently living at the shelter is 23. The number of homeless children in the Salem-Keizer school district is 924.

There is always a waiting list to move into the shelter and the goal is to help families get back on their own in about six months. The shelter is not affiliated with any church and receives only about \$6,000 from FEMA (Federal Emergency Management Agency). The remainder of funding is from community grants and donations.

Families move into furnished apartments and all include cooking utensils, beds and linens and small TV's and VCR's.

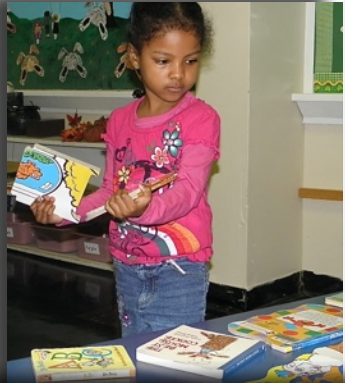
St. Vincent de Paul School
