Oregon State Fire Marshal IMTs



Our Guest Speaker today was Mariah Rawlins. She is the Incident Management Teams (IMT) Program Coordinator for the Oregon State Fire Management Office, which employs



53 people in 13 regions throughout the state. Mariah is the one employee in the Program Coordinator office. She is also the step-daughter of Hugh Nelson. Mariah joined the state agency in 2011. The Oregon Office of State Fire Marshal was established in 1917 with the State Insurance Commissioner serving as ex-officio State Fire Marshal. In 1963, the Legislative Assembly separated the Office of State Fire Marshal from the insurance commissioner and placed it directly under the Governor. Another legislative change in 1971 incorporated the OSFM under the Department of Commerce and provided for the appointment of a State Fire Marshal and the establishment of a separate administrative office. In 1999 the State Fire Defense Board asked the OSFM to develop a system of coordination for resource mobilized to conflagrations.

The IMT program is a huge coordination operation involving numerous agencies involved in dealing with: Wildland-urban interface fires, Floods, Line of duty deaths, Active shooter incidents, and Full-scale functional exercises.



Club History continued from last week: Many club traditions began in those early days. By 1961, new members were wearing the Mansfield apron which all members were to sign as they introduced themselves. New members were asked to give a geographical sketch when introduced by their sponsor. Fining began at the first meeting, with a 10 cent fine for not calling a member by his first name. The club took an active leadership role in both Kiwanis and the community from the start. There have been 10 Lieutenant Governors from our club and at least 2 Key Clubs sponsored. The first project was to raise funds for a Courthouse clock. Other major projects have included raising \$500,000 for Willamette University in the early days, \$200,000 for construction of the present YMCA building, sponsorship of expansion of Chemawa Indian School, Silver Falls State Park, and many others. Our club and its members helped organize and launch the first community-wide fundraising campaign for Community Chest, the forerunner of the present United Way "Camp-ships" and helped with camp projects for YMCA, Boy Scouts, Camp Fire, and Girl Scouts date back to the early days. One of our members, past Governor of Oregon, Douglas McKay was chosen Secretary of the Interior in 1953 by President Eisenhower. (to be continued)
