New Salem Police Center Project Evolution:

The City Council has been working to address the possibility of a new headquarters for the Salem Police Department since 2007. Last November, voters rejected a plan to build a 148,000 square-foot police facility. In recent polling, those residents cited the \$82.1 million cost as a major negative factor.

On February 6, 2017, Council held a work session and accepted public comment to consider whether to refer a proposal for a new public safety facility to the voters again at the May 16, 2017 election.

On February 21, 2017, Council held a work session and accepted public comment to consider whether to refer a proposal for a new public safety facility and seismic and structural improvements to the Library to Salem voters.

Council adopted a motion to call for a May 16, 2017 election for a \$61.8 million bond measure to finance a public safety facility. They also adopted a motion to call for an election on the November 7, 2017 ballot for \$15.3 million bond measure to finance seismic and building safety improvements for the City Library.
