Union Gospel Mission has eight different facilities in and around Salem, including the downtown mens' facility where some 200 men find a place to stay and are fed and helped with several recovery programs. There is also a women and children facility, Simonka Place in Keizer which shelters 62 women and children.

Last year UGM served almost 2,000 folks in Salem.
