**Kyle Dickinson** is Vice President of Advancement for the mission. He is involved in fundraising, community engagement and volunteers. Speaking of volunteers, the mission has a staff of about 60 and some 500-600 volunteers.

Union Gospel Mission has eight different facilities in and around Salem, including the downtown mens' facility where some 200 men find a place to stay and are fed and helped with several recovery programs. There is also a women and children facility, Simonka Place in Keizer which shelters 62 women and children.

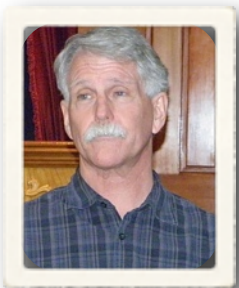
Last year UGM served almost 2,000 folks in Salem.
