Results:

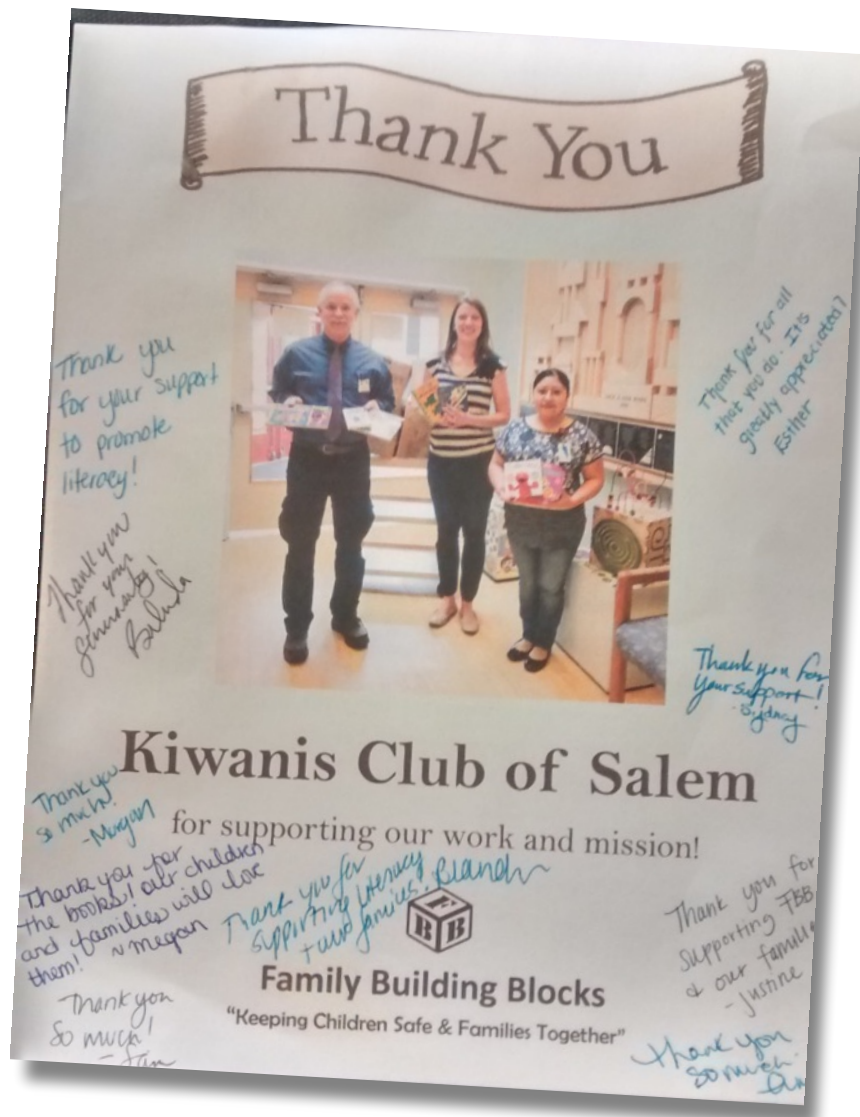
Books delivered to 100 locations in Marion and Polk counties.
