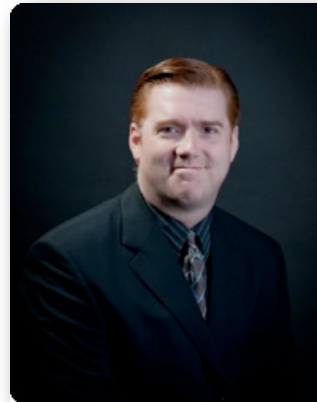

**O**ur speaker today is an "off spring" of one our very own members, Norm Frink! Scot Frink is currently the owner of Salem Audiology Clinic formally owned by Norm. Scot Frink grew up in the field of audiology, his father having started Salem Audiology Clinic in 1981, Scott mentioned that when he was 3 years old his dad would use Scot's ear as a "simple" when practicing the art of making ear molds used in the business. Scot obtained his degree in audiology in 2004, but had been involved hearing aid repair since 1990 and dispensing hearing aids since 1995. He previously worked as regional trainer for Phonak Hearing systems from 1999 - 2001 in Oregon, Washington, Idaho, Montana and Alaska, before returning to private practice in 2002. He has presented numerous seminars on technology and practice development for state associations in his region. He is a contributing editor for Your Health magazine, a local periodical. He is passionate about assisting the hearing impaired, serving on the Oregon State Hearing Aid



Licensing Board since 2002, with a strong focus on consumer rights. Scot mentioned how young this field is as it really got its start right after WW II with many of the returning Veteran's suffered from hearing loss. He stated that even today the Veteran program fits over 20% of the hearing aids fitted in the United States. He talked about the challenges the industry faces with the changes in moving from a Master requirement to a PHD and the growing number of citizens, the baby boomers, that will be needing hearing devices in the coming years. He strongly encourages individuals looking for great job opportunities to look at Audiology as a growing profession in the years to come.
