**M**arilyn Daily has been the Director at Center 50+ (previously known at City of Salem Senior Center) since 1999. She graduated from WOSC in Public Policy Administration and Sociology with special emphasis on Aging and Maturing. She is a mother of four children ranging from 7-19 years old, and lives in West Salem.



Highlights of her career include: Being the First in the State of Oregon to Achieve National Accreditation, Building the new Center, Strategic Planning for the Future of Salem's Older Adults, bringing the Center to financial stability, representing the State of Oregon on the National Institute of Senior Center's Delegate Council, and Center 50+ recognized for Outstanding Facility of The Year and Outstanding Program of the Year by Oregon Recreation Park Association.

### **Program Notes**

The center serves over 1,000 individuals a day with the help of over 600 volunteers. Their funding coming from the City making up about 30% and the balance comes from fees associated with programs, grants, continuous funding reasoning from their non-profit committee and 25% support of local business acting as major sponsors for the center. The structure that is used in the center is focused on the programs offered where they become "clubs" with elected officers by those that participate. The center acts as the sponsor and operator of the space, lights, heat and other structural components that make the programs

independently and collectively successful.

Marilyn describes the Center 50+ in the following manner:

Center 50+ is a growing, dynamic organization poised to meet the evolving needs of the 50+ population of today and tomorrow. The Center welcomes input from new participants and partners to help develop a center that meets the needs of those ages 50 and older and serves the community.
