Bob Tribotti was KOD today. Here are his remarks:

Today is my 42nd wedding anniversary. My wife Susan and I have a daughter who is 32 years old and lives and works in Brooklyn New York at the MTA museum.

I also have 2 daughters from my first marriage.

I was born in Rochester New York in 1941. Rochester was America's first boomtown due to the fertile Genesee River Valley.

It is the birthplace of Western Union, Xerox, Bousch & Lomb, and Eastman Kodak Company. Both of my parents worked at

Kodak, one of Rochester's biggest employers at the time. My father was an amateur photographer printing his photos in his home darkroom.

I took art & photography classes in high school. After graduating high school, I joined the Air Force where I spent four years in the military police.

While in the service, I took a correspondence course in drafting. My first job after the service was as a draftsman. I studied advertising design and photography at Art Center College of Design in Pasadena California. I became a technical illustrator and then became a graphic designer in the late 1960's.

In 1970 I started a graphic design business in Southern California. Some of my clients included Lockheed Martin, Northrop Corporation, Southwestern Law School, the actor Martin Milner, of Route 66 fame, and the cities of Calabasas and Ventura California.

I continued my advertising design business after moving to Oregon in 2005 until retiring in 2012.

I joined Kiwanis in 1998, twenty years ago. I was the first president of the Kiwanis Club of Calabasas in California.


