An invasive plant has the ability to thrive and spread aggressively

outside its natural range. A naturally aggressive plant may be especially invasive when it is introduced to a new habitat.

An invasive species that colonizes a new area may gain an ecological edge since the insects, diseases, and foraging animals that naturally keep its growth in check in its native range are not present in its new habitat.

Our guest speaker today was **Tanya Beard**, a Botanist who graduated from OSU. She has taught botany, horticulture and organic gardening at Oregon State Correctional Institution.

Her slide presentation showed how difficult it is to identify “escapes from gardens.” Some 65% of plants in Oregon home gardens are not native to Oregon. And some of these plants are beautiful in their own right, but they can also be toxic and dangerous to humans and animals.

The Giant Hogweed plant stands 10 to 15 feet high. The stems of the flowers are hollow and the sap will cause blistering and burns on the skin. Another problem invasive plant is Scotch Broom, the seeds can survive in the soil for 70 years.



KOD Shirley Clemens was our KOD today. Shirley is an “Eastern Oregon Girl,” born and raised in Baker City. She went through school in Baker City. Her grandparents and parents all are native to Eastern Oregon. Shirley will be our “vocational speaker” on July 1st and she will then tell us how she went from being an Eastern Oregon Girl to a Salem Girl.

Shirley asked questions about how observant we are. Questions such as how many colors are on a Campbell’s Soup can?
