Hugh Nelson (Col. retired) Introduced our Flag Day program today, with three members of the Oregon Army National Guard Honors Team. The team performs this solemn flag ceremony at about 30 military burials a month. As the flag was folded, 13 folds, Hugh told the meaning of each fold. He also told us about the symbolism of the flag colors and design. Each element, color and shape signifying an aspect of our country's history and traditions. Flag Day was established on May 30, 1916 under President Woodrow Wilson.
