For FY 2018, \$2.6 billion in prizes and \$725 million to state and local programs was distributed. The Oregon Lottery is always in a state of change. Modernizing and upgrading the games is a constant endeavor. The future of the Oregon Lottery includes looking at a return to sports betting in the state.

The new aspects of a mobile application for the Lottery is being explored. A continuing commitment to responsible gaming and support for problem gambling is a high priority for the Lottery.

Honesty and integrity are the guiding principles of the Oregon Lottery. Working with and collaborating with government, community, and industry is what makes the Oregon Lottery a success for all Oregonians.
