PROGRAM – THE BRIDGE

The program today was about the new Peter Courtney Minto Island Bridge. Senior Project Manager **Aaron Kimsey** presented information on the status of the construction of the bridge which has been an idea of the city of Salem since the 1970's. The bridge is named after Peter Courtney who was on the Salem City Council at the time. He has been a prime advocate and supporter of the idea of connecting central Salem with the Minto Island area with a bike and pedestrian walkway.

The two year \$10 million project is scheduled to be completed by late fall of this year. It is truly a unique bridge, no other like it in the whole country. It will be a clear span 14 foot wide bridge with no foundations in the water. When completed the total area connected by the bridge will be larger than Central Park in New York City. There will be some 20 miles of walkways and paths. Visitors will enjoy the beauty of nature including wild life in the center of the city.
