Salem Board Meeting August 12 - Marco Polo Eric Schmidt has been with the Association of Oregon Counties (AOC) for the past eight and a half years.



Prior to AOC he was a reporter, anchor and producer for TV and Radio in Portland, Los Angeles, Denver and Colorado Springs.

The subject of his very informative talk today was the history and future of the Federal Forest Payments system in Oregon. In 1937 Congress passed the O&C Act, Oregon & California Railroad revested lands act. Oregon is the only state that receives revenue from O&C lands. Revenues go directly to county general funds. In early 1990's timber harvests on federal forest land and O&C land declined by 90%. Three counties use these funds for over 60% of their general funds. This is a major problem for the future.
