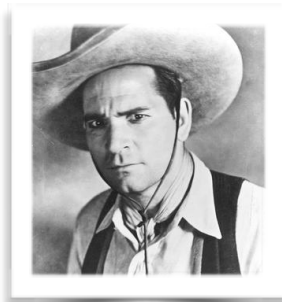

Our featured member today was **John Moody**. John noted that he has lived in Salem for 23 years, longest he has ever lived in one place. Before moving to Salem, he lived in Southern California where he was a minister and would sometimes officiate at memorial services for celebrities who passed away.

One such movie actor was **Yakima Canutt**, who John got to know, and when he died, the family asked John to do the memorial service. John was told that **Charlton Heston**, who drove the chariot in the movie *Ben-Hur* that Yakima did the stunt in, would also say a few words at the service, but, turns out Mr. Heston was unable to attend the services for Yakima but his son **Fraser Heston**, who was a film director, did attend the services in place of his father.

Our guest speaker today was Rabbi **Avrohom Yitzchok-Perlstein**. Rabbi Perlstein is one of three Chaplains at the Oregon State Penitentiary in Salem, where he has served as a chaplain since 2013 and as a volunteer since 2008. The other 2 are a Buddhist and a Christian Chaplain.

He talked about the challenges of his work and "we talk about the way it is" and how our system of incarceration is not working. He sees his work as an advocate for the inmates. He brought up the concept of "Restorative Justice" and how our "locking people up" does not solve the problems of our society.

From Wikipedia...A restorative justice program aims to get offenders to take responsibility for their actions, to understand the harm they have caused, to give them an opportunity to redeem themselves and to discourage them from causing further harm. For victims, its goal is to give them an active role in the process and to reduce feelings of anxiety and powerlessness.
