Don Ferguson was our KOD today. Don has a story going back to the Great Depression and the Dust Bowl. He was born in the “conservative

town of Liberal Kansas, three miles from the Oklahoma border.”

The time was in the middle of the Great Depression. Don’s parents were farmers and his brothers worked on the farm with their dad. Don talked about the many tragedies in the family during those years. His father had an accident with farming equipment, damaging one leg bone causing one leg to be shorter than the other. On his father’s birthday, a gasoline barrel exploded killing Don’s oldest brother and severely burning his other brother. His young sister died from appendicitis. A tornado wiped out their house and Don’s mother survived after being found in the rubble. They lost the farm and were in bad financial shape but through it all, the family kept their faith and inspired their children and “left the children with a legacy of strength and courage.”

Don was married to the love of his life Mildred, for 47 years. She passed away three years ago.

Our featured guest speaker today was very knowledgeable & informative. Colonel (ret.) **Laine Encabo** is the Director of Oregon **ESGR**



Employer Support of the Guard and Reserve Program. Col. Encabo is a graduate of OSU. He entered the service right after graduation.

After 4 years of active duty he became a full time employee of the Army National Guard where he served until retirement in 2011. He was a Combat Engineer for his entire career.

The ESGR program is a DOD program started in 1972. The mission of ESGR is to foster a culture where employers support and value the employment of service members and veterans. The Ombudsman Services aspect of the program is available free to both employers and service members. The Federal Law known as USERRA, passed in 1994, is designed to advocate and inform both the service member and the employer.

The second part of Colonel Encabo’s presentation was on H2H - Hire to Heros. This program is charged with helping the service member in gaining employment after their service career is over. This program has a web site that lists openings by military-friendly employers with job openings. The service is free to both employer and the veteran job seeker.
