She reported on the recent legislative session at the state capitol. On a scale of 1-10 she gave the session a 5.

Some things got done, like balancing the budget, which is a good thing, and some did not like PERS reform. Some things in Oregon are doing well, like agriculture, some things, like employment are not so good.

The Oregon economy is slowly getting better, but

many challenges remain.

The PERS system accounts for 25% of the state budget. PERS funding issues were not solved in this session.

Governor Kitzhaber has indicated he may call a special session to deal with the PERS fiscal problems.
